A year ago, Ezra Argentina started online Ulpan classes, for learning Hebrew, for those who were preparing to go to Israel and for those who already had arrived in Israel.

The classes have proven to be a real success and offer emotional and pastoral support to Olim. There are two classes running, one in Israeli time and another in Argentinian time.

"We help the Olim all the way to the airport, but the journey does not stop there: after that, we stay in contact with many of them, some through the Ulpan classes, some through private messages. The journey to make Aliyah is not easy; it's like a roller coaster. At times they are "on top," full of joy and hope; other times, they feel the "drop," full of fear and frustration. In those moments, we uphold them, we embrace them. Many have told us that no other organisation truly shows up for them — but with us, they feel they can trust us, because we are present, we give them our time, we share a coffee and we open our hearts to them."

PRAYER POINTS FOR EZRA ARGENTINA: Greater openness from Jewish institutions; More empathy towards the Olim from the organisations involved in helping with Aliyah; More connections with pastors, leaders, congregations, and ministries – increasing commitment and compassion for Israel /Jewish people; New Olim; G-d to renew our strength to continue serving His people with love.
