


SCOTTISH CONFERENCE

Vita and her husband have five children. The family went through consular checks before the start of the full-scale war in Ukraine. It then became clear they needed a DNA test to prove Vita was Jewish, through her aunt in Israel.

When the war began, the family left Ukraine to Italy as refugees. Initially they lived in a comfortable hotel but after a while they were moved to a hostel which was dangerous.



Do you know of any youth groups in your church or nearby that would welcome Pat or one of our team to come and speak to youth regarding why Aliyah is important and what one might do to support it? Whilst it seems a small minority of the UK youth groups who would entertain such a guest, we hear from our Russian field leader that God is stirring up a new love for Israel in the Russian youth! In the picture on bottom left corner of the first page of this newsletter, Russian youth are committing themselves to stand with G-d's purposes for Israel! This is happening at several churches in Russia! Let's praise our G-d for this development and commit ourselves to pray that this would happen here in the UK and elsewhere in the world! Please also pray that any youth attending our conference this Saturday would be impacted by G-d's love for Israel and be called to action!



No Safe Place but Israel!



A hostel is not a safe place for a Jewish family: Vita and family (above) are experiencing harassment, even a threat to their lives in their current 'refuge'. Vita's youngest son's Hebrew name became known to neighbours. One day several Arabs attacked Benjamin and started strangling him! Thankfully by-standers intervened and Benjamin's life was spared! Vita is desperate to take her family to a safe place - which means Israel! Please pray for G-d's protection on this family. Pray for the costly process of the DNA testing (through Israeli courts) and for the resources for this. Pray that everything can be arranged quickly!
